INCIDENTS

10/10/23 – Mermaid Lane & Beech Lane – Officers responded to the area for several reports of vehicles being broken into with items stolen. Several Officers were able to locate the subjects shortly after the commission of the crimes and all three males were arrested.

10/11/23 – Cheltenham Avenue/Ogontz Avenue (Cheltenham Twp) – Members of the Springfield Township Traffic Safety Unit and other Officers assigned to the Eastern Montgomery County Crash Team assisted Cheltenham Police with a fatal car crash. Springfield Officers helped with crash reconstruction and provided coverage for Cheltenham units while the crash was investigated. Springfield Officers returned to service in approximately two hours when the scene was released.

10/11/23 – 1300 block Mermaid Lane – While on patrol, Officers located an occupied vehicle parked in a closed township park. Officers ensured that there was no issue, advised the occupants of the park hours, and they were sent on their way without issue.

10/15/2023 – 7800 block Louise Lane – Officers were notified that a subject was in the area that possibly had a warrant for their arrest. Several Officers responded to the area and located an individual matching the description. The individual did have an active warrant for their arrest from the Pennsylvania State Police and was taken into custody.
