INCIDENTS

3/25/24 – 100 block Northwestern Avenue – Officers were dispatched to the area for a report of a vehicle that was broken into. After speaking with the owner, it was determined that someone smashed their window and stole an iPhone and a wallet while they were not with the vehicle. Officers were not able to obtain a description of an actor and remained in the area for a greater Officer presence.

3/26/24 – 100 block Montgomery Avenue – Officers were dispatched to the area for a suspicious group of males in Cisco Park after hours. Officers were able to locate the subjects that were there filming a music video. The subjects were advised of the park hours and left without incident.

3/31/24 – Willow Grove Avenue/Douglas Road – Officers were dispatched to the area for a two-vehicle crash. When units arrived on scene, one of the drivers provided false identification to the Officers. The subject was subsequently taken into custody for his identity to be confirmed. It was discovered that the subject was a juvenile male and was ultimately released to a parent.

3/31/24 – Willow Grove Avenue/Sandy Hill Road – Officers attempted to conduct a traffic stop on a vehicle after observing multiple moving violations. The vehicle fled the scene of the stop prior to Officers making contact with the driver. Surrounding agencies were given a description of the vehicle, but it was not located. After further investigation, the registered owner of the vehicle was identified and there is an active arrest warrant in place by another agency.
