Staff update - no update, techno trash cans are doing well

BoC update - Municipal campus moving forward, changing location to Seven Dolores soon. The sewer system was sold to Bucks County Water and Sewer. Unanimous vote on the MS4/TMDL collaboration agreement

Cisco Grant update - Solicitor letter, Fish & Game information, agreement with neighbors and new drawing are on track. Stephen is on lead for taking up the signage effort on the grant.

Township newsletter - due end of February

Guest Presentation - Susan Myerov, PEC on the MS4 and TMDL (total max daily load) collaboration agreement and what PEC, WVV are working with townships in the watershed to meet the TMDL reductions as outlined by the EPA. TMDL's are required to be reduced as part of the MS4 permitting. The EPA is open to the watershed collaboration between municipalities within a watershed like this agreement. Discussed opportunities for EAC's within the watershed to help educate and participate. Point sources of pollution are well known and understood how to remediate. Non-point sources (e.g. storm water) are more difficult to address.

Activities for the year:

- Put out a call (township blast) for volunteers to host an EAC open house similar to the one which was done last year.
- EAC "Tour of the Township" to visit a number of the areas in the township of interest from a sustainability perspective.
