



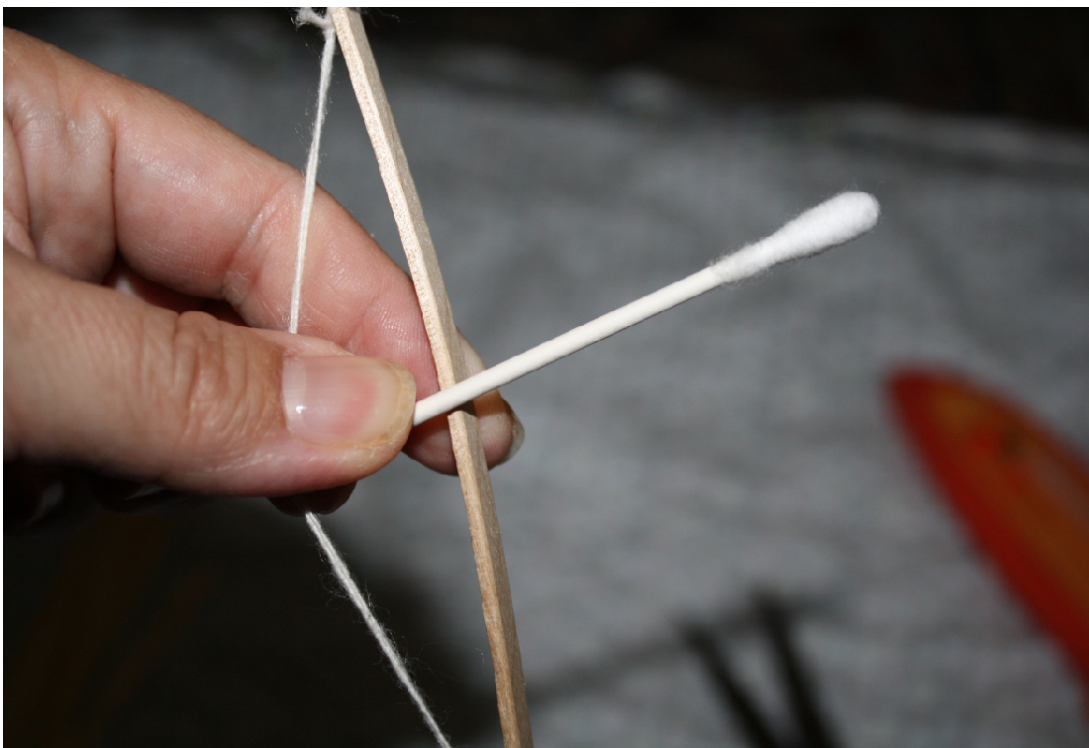

DIY Bow and Arrow





Materials needed to make both styles of bow:

Skewer or thin stick

2 Craft Sticks

Thin cord or string

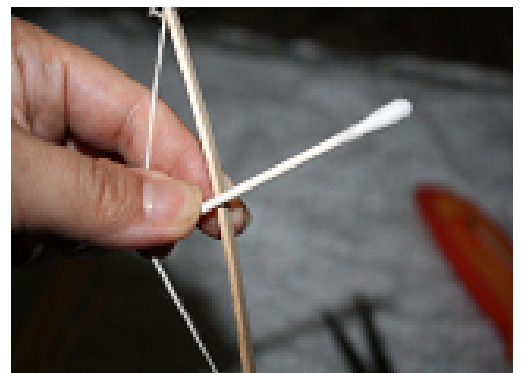
Tape - Duct Tape, Masking Tape or Electrical Tape

Q-tips

DIY Bow and Arrow

Directions for Skewer:

1. Cut a piece of cord about 10" long.
2. Tie the cord in a knot at one end of the skewer.
3. Tape down the knot with strong tape (duct tape, masking tape, or electrical tape) near the end of the skewer covering the tail of the knot.
4. Repeat the knot and tape on the other end; only need a little bit of slack in the cord.
5. Pull back the cord, secure the Q-tip (the arrow) and release.



Directions for Craft Sticks:

1. Tape craft sticks together, end to end with strong tape.
2. Cut a piece of cord about 18" long.
3. Tape down the knot with strong tape (duct tape, masking tape, or electrical tape) near the end of the craft sticks covering the tail of the knot.
4. Repeat the knot and tape on the other end; only need a little bit of slack in the cord.
5. Pull back the cord, secure the Q-tip (the arrow) and release.
