




SUMMER OF M.E. (MEANINGFUL ENTERTAINMENT) PRESENTS

DIY Bow and Arrow





Materials needed to make both styles of bow:

Skewer or thin stick
2 Craft Sticks
Thin cord or string
Tape - Duct Tape, Masking Tape or Electrical Tape
Q-tips

DIY Bow and Arrow

Directions for Skewer:

- Cut a piece of cord about 10" long.
- Tie the cord in a knot at one end of the skewer.
- Tape down the knot with strong tape (duct tape, masking tape, or electrical tape) near the end of the skewer covering the tail of the knot.
- Repeat the knot and tape on the other end; only need a little bit of slack in the cord.
- Pull back the cord, secure the Q-tip (the arrow) and release.

Directions for Craft Sticks:

- Tape craft sticks together, end to end with strong tape.
- Cut a piece of cord about 18" long.
- Tape down the knot with strong tape (duct tape, masking tape, or electrical tape)
 near the end of the craft sticks covering the tail of the knot.
- Repeat the knot and tape on the other end; only need a little bit of slack in the cord.
- Pull back the cord, secure the Q-tip (the arrow) and release.
