Energy Transition Plan Updates

- Energy Procurement / Energy Efficiency
 - Aaron : sub-committees will be combined
 - Possible to have township participate in a demand response program. Next step
 to have them look at PECO bills if we could participate on our own, or be
 combined with another municipality(s).
 - Getting credit through grid operator: energy efficiency credits and street light related credits.

EV Group update

- Desiree change name of group, more about mobility efficiency (covering more than just hybrid cars)
- First Hybrid patrol car on the streets in march; post to see what they would be saving. Hybrid ~\$3500 more, payback on that would be ~ 1 yr. With updated gas prices, payback is ~ 1.5 yrs based on more current estimates.
- Draft of section ~15-16 pages long; seeking input, wordsmithing, consolidation, etc....
- Upper Dublin is looking towards us, like we have looked at other townships.

School District Group

- Melissa got a response from Craig Thorn, District Operational Director. Moving forward with his PECO contact for the auditor and will follow-up with us after the initial audit. There is a new business admin, so it will take time. New LED lights, energy efficient chillers, etc...
- Susan Dannenberg walkability/rideability connected with Melissa for the Chreshim
 Trail. Something to build in as part of the larger plan.

Mermaid Park update

 BoC approved moving forward with the design process. ~2 months, includes a wetland study and the bid documents.

- Project will restore the stream bank and install a sediment forebay (allow for not having to dredge the pong), dredging the pond. Perimeter trail for passive recreation.
 Additional funding we are looking at could allow us to widen the path to allow for bicycles as well. Include a connector to the Cheshim Trail.
- Materials for the path are being considered, possibly pourous, and access for differently abled people.
- Side discussion, Parks and Recs has a program for buying a memorial tree or bench, more information on their website: https://springfieldmontco.org/departments/parks-recreation/
- Regional Local Climate Action Plan (LCAP)
 - Brandon participating in this. Free via ICCLE through Montgomery Co. planning commission for the development of that plan.
