IF NOT YOU, THEN WHO?

Springfield Township Code 53-8 states, “No person shall throw or deposit litter in any park within the township, except in public receptacles and in such a manner that the litter will be prevented from being carried or deposited by the elements upon any part of the park or upon any street or other public place.



Where public receptacles are not provided, all such litter shall be carried away from the park by the person responsible for its presence and properly disposed of elsewhere as provided herein.”

Despite this, excess litter continues to be a problem in Township parks and facilities. We are counting on Springfield residents to help curb our litter problem.

Our Township is dedicated to making sure our parks are a clean and enjoyable experience for all patrons. We would like to remind all park users to properly dispose of trash during their visit. If you are visiting the park and see trash on the ground, please take the initiative to help keep our parks clean by picking up what another person left behind.
