General Public Comment / Open Forum

- Springfield Open Space recent approved for 501(c)3, can now apply for grants. Recently completed native pollinator garden on Stenton and Ivy. Township assisted, people donated plants. Other projects in the works.
- Alexander Klinger brought up the concern that the township has decided to pause grant writing per the outgoing assistant township manager.
- Open Space plan in the township: Last done in 2005. Needs to be updated.

Community Outreach

- Some posting; Designate in the subject to Aaron that it is for a EAC FB posting.
- Streaming : old device won't work, will look at an alternative to do this. Aaron and Stephen to coordinate.

Old business

- EAC Shirts Aaron to follow-up with getting some EAC shirts, to wear as members for the events.
- Community day: Sunday October 1st: 10 am 1pm
 - Have a page with the QR code to direct them to the EAC page and some basic instructions for signing up to the township newsletter.
 - Theme 1 : Electrification
 - Aaron to provide his electric lawn equipment
 - Inflation Reduction Act targeted to Springfield residents of what they do
 - Joy: Would like to create a pamphlet to hand out at community day and also post on the website
 - o Theme 3 : Single use plastic bag ordinance
 - Raffle / Give Away :
 - What to focus and who can donate the item?
 - How are we going to manage the sign-ups for the raffle? (QR code to sign up for it) Capture email address, name and phone number.

- Aaron working with public works on their electrification; they are replacing equipment with electric versions as the life cycle.

 - They need 5 volunteers; 2 hours helping people with stuff and directing traffic/people.
 - Timed event, will take as much as they can during that period and then its over.
 - Aaron -> Zeta : can they provide us numbers on the volume collected.
 - Promotional materials : who is responsible? EAC (Zeta). Also coordinate with the schools to promote it.
 - Check to make sure there are not any competing events. Places like county and weavers way or others.
 - Zeta: get those dates to Aaron.
