FISHING IN SPRINGFIELD PARKS

With a valid PA Fishing License, patrons of all ages are permitted to fish at Sandy Run Quarry. At Hillcrest Pond, fishing is limited to patrons 15 years and younger or 65 year and older. Fishing is not permitted at Mermaid Park. Springfield Township recommends a daily limit of two fish per person. Trout season will open statewide on Saturday, April 6.
