INCIDENTS

3/6/2024 – Chesney Lane/Longfield Road – Officers were dispatched to the area for a suspicious vehicle with tinted windows circling the area. Several Officers responded to the area to locate the vehicle but were unsuccessful. Officers continued to canvass the area throughout the remainder of the shift.
