INCIDENTS

4/9/24 – 1600 block Bethlehem Pike – While Officers were on patrol, they noticed a vehicle parked in a closed business' parking lot occupying three spaces. Officers noticed that a male was asleep behind the steering wheel of the vehicle and he refused to identify himself after the Officers made contact. Eventually the male identified himself and was sent on his way after confirming his identity.

4/9/24 – 1000 block S. Easton Rd (Cheltenham) – Springfield Township Officers were dispatched to assist the Cheltenham Township Police Department after reports were received of a shooting at a local business. Several Officers arrived on scene and determined that a shooting did not take place. Springfield Units were quickly returned to normal patrol operations.

4/10/24 – 1000 block Cromwell Road – Officers were dispatched to a local residence for a well-being check. When Officers arrived, they located a deceased female. Detectives from Springfield Township Police and the Montgomery County Detective Bureau responded to the scene for processing. This incident is still an ongoing investigation. No further information is permitted to be released at this time.

4/11/24 – Springfield Twp – Officers and Detectives of several agencies executed warrant services on a corrupt organization that is responsible for large amounts of drugs and illegal firearms. Springfield Township Police, Montgomery County Detective Bureau, Jenkintown Borough Police, and Lower Salford Township Police took seven subjects into custody without issue as part of the Montgomery County Violent Gun Task Force investigation. This incident is still an ongoing investigation. No further information is permitted to be released at this time.

4/12/24 – 8200 block Cheltenham Avenue (Cheltenham) – Springfield Township Officers responded to assist the Cheltenham Township Police and Cheltenham Township Fire Departments at a house fire on the border of both townships. Springfield Units assisted with evacuation of neighboring homes as well as crowd control. Units were returned to normal patrol operations after an hour on scene.
