INCIDENTS

5/13/24 – 300 block Cheltenham Avenue (Cheltenham) – Springfield Officers responded to the area after an “Officer Needs Assistance” was broadcasted via county radio. Cheltenham Police were able to get the incident under control prior to Springfield Police arriving on scene.

5/14/24 – 1800 block Bethlehem Pike – While on a detail at a local business, Officers observed a physical fight taking place. Several additional Officers responded to the scene to assist with separating parties and crowd control. The aggressor in this incident fled the scene on foot, and several surrounding agencies assisted with attempting to locate the male.

5/17/24 – 1500 block Pleasant Avenue – Officers were dispatched to the area for a vehicle fire in front of a residence. Springfield Police along with the Wyndmoor Fire Company responded to the scene to get the fire under control. The investigation on the cause of the fire has been turned over to the Fire Marshal’s Office and the Criminal Investigation Division of the Police Department.

5/17/24 – 300 block Lyster Road – Officers were dispatched to a report of a male wearing a ski mask ringing the doorbell and running off. A group of juveniles were located at Marlow Field and then fled into the woods. Ultimately the juvenile was identified and referred to the Youth Aid Panel, and he and his parent were warned about the danger of wearing a ski mask and doing “Ding, Dong, Ditch.”
