INCIDENTS:

11/19/2024- Officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of Pennsylvania Avenue report of a physical disturbance in progress where one of the parties had used pepper spray. The aggressor had left the scene and was stopped a short time later while driving home and placed into custody for simple assault.
