INCIDENTS:

1/20/25 – Officers responded to a call for theft in progress at Wawa on the 1600 block of Bethlehem Pike. Upon arrival, the store manager described the juveniles who left on foot. From the description, another patrol officer was able to locate them. The three juveniles placed into custody for retail theft and released to family members.

1/21/25 – Officers responded to a call for a disturbance at Fairwold Academy. After police reviewed the video footage, one juvenile was placed into custody for simple assault and released to a family member.

1/23/25 - Police conducted a traffic stop on a driver who was driving in the area of Oreland Mill Road and Burton Road with their high beams on and making sudden stops. Subsequently, the driver was arrested and taken into custody for driving under the influence.
