INCIDENTS:

3/11/25 – While on patrol in Oreland, police observed a vehicle on Station Ave with a heavily tinted windshield and side windows, as well as a headlight out. The officer conducted a traffic stop at the intersection of Willow Grove Ave and Fenton Rd. While speaking with the driver, the officer noticed the smell of burnt marijuana and observed a lit roach in the center console. The officers performed standard field sobriety tests on the driver and he was taken into custody for suspicion of DUI.

3/11/25 - While patrolling the area of Paper Mill Rd and Church Rd, police observed a vehicle turning right onto Church Rd while the light was steady red. Since that intersection has a clearly posted "No turn on red" sign, the officer initiated a traffic stop. While speaking with the driver, the officer noticed slurred speech and confusion, as well as a strong odor of marijuana emanating from the vehicle. The officer also observed an empty alcoholic beverage bottle inside the vehicle. The officers performed standard field sobriety tests on the driver. Based on the results of the tests, she was taken into custody without incident.

3/12/25 – While checking tags in the Oreland section of the township, police ran a plate and found the owner of the vehicle to have a warrant. The owner was identified by his state photo ID and was seen approaching the vehicle. Officers confirmed his identity and his warrant. The male was taken into custody without incident.

3/13/25 – One female with a warrant turned herself in at the police station and was taken into custody.
