INCIDENTS:

3/31/25 – Police responded to the TD Bank on the 200 block of Bethlehem Pike for a report of a male attempting to cash a fraudulent check. Upon further investigation, police were able to identify the juvenile male and confirm that the check was fraudulent. They also found another fraudulent check in his possession. The juvenile male was taken into custody for forgery.

4/3/25 – Police responded to a report of theft at the Giant on the 1800 block of Bethlehem Pike. Giant's asset protection stopped the male before police arrived. The male was taken into custody for retail theft.
