INCIDENTS:

4/9/25 – Police were dispatched to Fairwold Academy on the 2100 block of Pennsylvania Avenue for a delayed report of an assault of a teacher by a student. The school was able to provide security video footage of the incident. The student involved has been referred to the Youth Aid Panel.

4/9/25 – Police were dispatched to the 1100 block of Ivy Hill Road for the report of a suspicious male who was walking around and then laid down on the curb. When the officer arrived and made contact with the male, he stated that he was from Baltimore and was making his way to Philadelphia for work. After running his information through the system, it notified the officer that the male was missing out of Maryland. Officers were able to contact his family and bring him back to the station where a family member was able to pick him up.

4/13/25 – While conducting a traffic stop, police noticed a female pacing and exhibiting unsettling mannerisms while walking around on Bethlehem Pike. After a few minutes, the officer went to conduct a well-being check on the female. During the conversation, she mentioned that her ID and identity had been stolen and so the officer looked up her information by the name and date of birth that she provided. It came back in the system that she had an outstanding warrant in Montgomery County which was confirmed over the phone by the Montgomery County Sheriffs. She was placed into custody for her warrant.
