### INCIDENTS:

7/8/25 – Police responded to multiple calls for reports of theft from vehicles from overnight, mostly in the area of Kingston Rd and Drayton Rd. Reports have been turned over to the detective bureau and the investigation is ongoing.

7/13/25 – While on patrol, an officer observed a vehicle traveling on Cheltenham Ave turn onto Paper Mill Rd and failed to maintain its lane. The driver drove over the solid left yellow fog line.
