INCIDENTS:

7/28/25 – Police were dispatched to the 7700 block of Elm Ave for a report of a burglary. The homeowner came home from vacation and realized his back door was smashed in and some valuables were missing. The Detective Bureau was notified and the investigation is ongoing.

8/2/25 – While on patrol, an officer observed a vehicle that was stopped in the intersection of Paper Mill Rd and Cheltenham Ave. When the officer got closer and observed a female that appeared to be slumped over, he initiated a traffic stop. Upon approaching the vehicle on the driver's side, the officer observed the female packing what appeared to be marijuana into a glass pipe. The officer also observed multiple prescription containers and packaged pills in the vehicle. Due to the results of the field sobriety tests and ARIDE tests, the female was taken into custody for suspicion of DUI.
