INCIDENTS:

8/30/2025 – Police responded to a physical domestic call on the 7700 block of New St. A mother and daughter were separated prior to police arrival. The mother explained that they had an argument and then her daughter punched her. The juvenile female was cited with harassment and parties were separated for the evening.

8/30/2025 – Springfield Township Police and other local departments assisted Upper Dublin police with crowd control when fights occurred during a block party on the 300 block of Linden Ave in Upper Dublin Township.

8/31/25 — While patrolling the area of Church Rd and Route 309, an officer observed a vehicle traveling with an inoperable rear taillight. The officer initiated a traffic stop and the driver did not stop right away. Once the officer made contact with the driver, he observed slurred speech and a mostly empty bottle of liquor in the vehicle. The driver admitted to coming from a party in the area and exited the vehicle when asked. While speaking closely to officers, they noticed the odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath and bloodshot eyes. The driver declined field sobriety tests and a preliminary breath test. After being placed into custody for suspicion of DUI, officers also discovered that the male had a warrant for his arrest.
