INCIDENTS:

10/27/2025 – While conducting a drug interdiction detail, officers stopped a vehicle on Route 309 for a traffic violation. During the stop, the driver was found to have multiple active arrest warrants and was taken into custody. A search of the vehicle led to the discovery of narcotics and related paraphernalia. The passenger was also taken into custody and charged with drug-related offenses. Both individuals were referred for evaluation and treatment resources.

10/30/2025 – While conducting a drug interdiction detail, officers were alerted of a stolen vehicle in the area through an automated license plate reader. Officers located the vehicle traveling north on Route 309 and confirmed the stolen status before activating emergency lights. Officers initiated a traffic stop on Paper Mill Rd. The driver was taken into custody without incident.

11/2/2025 – Officers were dispatched to the 1400 block of Paper Mill Rd for a report of a vehicle that crashed into a residence. Upon arrival, the driver was found outside the vehicle showing signs of impairment. The home sustained significant damage, but no injuries were reported. The driver was taken into custody under suspicion of driving under the influence. Charges are pending blood test results.
