INCIDENTS:

11/3/2025 – Police were dispatched to the 1100 block of Pleasant Ave for a report of a stolen vehicle. Upon further investigation, police contacted Kia's Stolen Vehicle Recovery Hotline and were able to recover the vehicle from Darby Township. The vehicle has been turned over to the Detective Bureau.

11/3/2025 – Police were dispatched to the 500 block of Spring Ln for a report of theft from vehicle. A few things were stolen from the resident's vehicle overnight. The information has been given to the Detective Bureau.

11/4/2025 – Police were dispatched to the 500 block of Auburn Ave for the report of a potential stalker in a vehicle outside of the caller's house. When police arrived, the vehicle was unoccupied, and officers then observed a male walking out from the side of the house. The male confirmed why he was at the house. He was taken into custody, interviewed, and charged for stalking, criminal trespassing, and other related charges.

11/9/2025 – Police were dispatched to the unit block of W. Wissahickon Ave for a vehicle crash. The driver crashed into a parked vehicle and showed signs of impairment while speaking with officers. She agreed to perform standardized field sobriety tests. Due to the crash, results of the tests, and signs of impairment, the driver was taken into custody for suspicion of DUI.
