INCIDENTS:

11/13/2025 – Police took reports for multiple vehicle break-ins. Some belongings were taken from vehicles, and some of the cars were just rummaged through.

11/16/2025 – Police were dispatched to Roesch Ave for a report of an accident and people screaming. Upon arrival, police observed a sedan with its hood up and a door open. An officer observed that the ignition was popped open and broken off, an indicator that the vehicle was stolen. One male, who admitted to driving the car was detained and told officers who else was in the vehicle. The vehicle was confirmed to be stolen, and the driver agreed that it was.
