INCIDENTS:

5/4/2026 – Springfield Township Police responded to the Flourtown Shopping Center to assist the local fire departments with an unoccupied vehicle fire.

5/5/2026 – Police were dispatched to the Giant on Bethlehem Pike for theft of a customer's wallet. The customer had her purse in the upper child seat part of the cart while she shopped and when she went to check out, her wallet was missing. When she went to the bank to cancel the cards, they alerted her of activity on the card since she had last seen it. The store manager provided security footage to the police. The case has been turned over to the Detective Bureau and the investigation is ongoing.

5/8/2025 – Police were dispatched to Walgreens on the 1400 block of Bethlehem Pike for the report of a theft-in-progress. Upon arrival, the store manager stated that the male left the store and went across the street in the direction of the coffee shop. Police located the juvenile male that was positively identified. He was taken into custody, charged with retail theft, and referred to the Youth Aid Panel.

5/10/2026 – Police were dispatched to the 100 block of McCloskey Rd for a report of a disturbance. A homeowner reported that someone threw a cinderblock through the window of the house. A neighbor witnessed this action and was able to provide police with a vehicle description and license plate. Police searched the area for the vehicle but did not locate them. The case has been turned over to the Detective Bureau and the investigation is ongoing.
