INCIDENTS:

5/25/2026 – An officer was conducting a property check at the Flourtown Plaza when he observed a vehicle enter the parking lot and abruptly exit the parking lot when he observed the patrol car. Since the businesses are closed at that time, the officer began driving behind the vehicle that abruptly turned without a turn signal. The officer conducted a traffic stop and could immediately smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the vehicle. The driver admitted to drinking alcohol and agreed to the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and a PBT. Based on the results of the tests, the male was arrested for suspicion of DUI, referred to the Youth Aid Panel, and released to a parent.

5/27/2026 – Police were dispatched to the Springfield Township High School. As a result of the investigation, two juveniles were taken into custody on marijuana-related charges.

5/30/2026 – Police were dispatched to Grove Ave in Flourtown for a disturbance. Upon arrival, police found a male hiding on the porch. Upon investigation, the male traveled to the female's house after being told not to return to the residence. The male tried to enter the house and was texting the female to let him in. She told him to leave. After talking with the male and female, he was arrested for Loitering and Prowling at Night Time. During a search incident to arrest, the male was found to be in possession of drug paraphernalia and was subsequently charged accordingly.
