INCIDENTS:

6/13/2026 – Montgomery Township advised Springfield and Cheltenham Police about a vehicle that had fled after committing retail theft. The dispatcher advised the vehicle description and that the vehicle was heading south on route 309. A Springfield officer pulled over the vehicle, but the vehicle then took off as soon as the officer started walking up to the window.

6/14/2026 – Police were dispatched to the ACME on the 1600 block of Bethlehem Pike for a report of theft and dispatch reported that the actors were still in the parking lot. Police were then advised of the vehicle description and tag that they left in. An officer found the vehicle that was occupied by people who matched the description and attempted to stop it. Instead of stopping as instructed, the vehicle hit the bumper of the police car and fled across a grass patch and into Philadelphia at a high rate of speed. Philadelphia Police was notified. The investigation is ongoing.
