INCIDENTS:

7/6/2026 – Police took multiple reports of a vehicles that were taken over night on the 500 block of Cresheim Valley Rd. The investigation is ongoing.

7/8/2026 – Police took a report of a vehicle that was taken over night on the 1200 block of St Clair Rd. Others that live on the 500 block of Paper Mill Rd reported seeing the same actors in ski masks going through their vehicles on security cameras. The investigation is ongoing.

7/9/2026 – While on patrol on Paper Mill Rd near the High School entrance, the officer pulled out behind a vehicle that the license plate reader didn't pick up on. The driver started to accelerate, drove through a red light, and tried to take off. The officer initiated a traffic stop and the driver attempted to get out of the vehicle. The county dispatcher then advised that the vehicle was stolen. The driver admitted to "finding" it with the keys in it. The driver was taken into custody for Receiving Stolen Property and other related charges.

7/10/2026 – While on patrol, an officer observed a vehicle parked in the center lane of Paper Mill Rd with the windshield wipers on as well as the turn signal. It was sunny and dry, so the officer turned around to check on the driver. Due to signs of impairment observed, the officer gave consented Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. In addition, Whitemarsh Police and K9 were called to the scene for the car. After the results of the test, the driver was taken into custody for suspicion of DUI. Additional charges pending a search warrant and blood results.
