INCIDENTS:

8/3/2026 – Police were dispatched to the 100 block of Atwood Rd for a vehicle that was rummaged through, but nothing was stolen.

8/4/2026 – Police were dispatched to a burglary of a business on the 900 block of Willow Grove Ave. Detectives responded and processed the scene. The investigation is ongoing.

8/4/2026 – While on patrol, an officer conducted a traffic stop for a vehicle with expired inspection stickers and dark tinted windows. The vehicle had a strong odor of burnt marijuana and there was a burnt marijuana roach in the center console. The driver denied there being any firearms in the vehicle, but a firearm fell out of the waistband of the passenger. The driver produced a fraudulent insurance card that belonged to someone else. The driver agreed to Standardized Field Sobriety tests. The driver was taken into custody for the Fraudulent Insurance, suspicion of DUI, possession of marijuana, and other related charges.

8/7/2026 – Police were dispatched to the 7600 block of Cheltenham Ave for a report of a stolen vehicle. The investigation is ongoing.

8/7/2026 – Police were dispatched to Fine Wine & Good Spirits on the 1400 block of Bethlehem Pike for a report of theft. Two males entered and left with multiple bottles of alcohol. Pictures, video footage, and car information that were provided to police aided in identifying the driver of the rented vehicle. An arrest warrant was issued and the investigation is ongoing.
