INCIDENTS:

8/12/2026 – Police were dispatched to a verbal domestic call on the unit block of Grove Ave. The male involved was violating a Protection from Abuse order and was taken into custody.

8/13/2026 – Police were speaking to the owner of a business that was broken into a few days prior. The owner mentioned that a separate night, the cash register was open and money was taken. There were pry marks on the register. The case was turned to the Detective Bureau and the investigation is ongoing.

8/13/2026 – Police were dispatched to 7-eleven on the 1000 block of Willow Grove Ave for a possible theft-in-progress. It was reported that a male ran out of the store being chased by employees. The employees reported that they recognized the male for multiple prior thefts. They tried to stop the male from going behind the counter, but he pushed their arms aside to get by. Officers were able to catch up with the juvenile male and take him into custody for robbery, theft, and other related charges. Employees confirmed that this was the male that has been stealing and security footage was provided to police.

8/15/2026 – Police were dispatched to Paper Mill Rd by Enfield Elementary for a male who appeared intoxicated and was stumbling. Police observed him stumbling in the road and crouching down. The male gave the officer false identification and started running away. He ran from police multiple times and ultimately was detained. Once he provided his real identification, it was discovered that he had an active arrest warrant out of the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office. He was taken into custody for his arrest warrant.
